Graduation Information

Graduation caps and gowns are planning to be delivered on April 1st and 7th at CSHS. A Herff Jones representative will be on campus those days for distribution of the Graduation items.

Graduation Practice will be from 1 PM - 2:30 PM on Thursday, May 21, 2026 at Reed Arena. All graduates are required to attend, and all graduating seniors must stay for the entire practice.

There is no limit to the number of guests students may have in the audience at graduation. Seating is on a first-come, first-served basis. **Graduation ceremonies begin at 8 PM on Friday, May, 22, 2026.** Due to traffic, plan to arrive early. All vehicles will be charged \$10 for parking at Texas A&M.

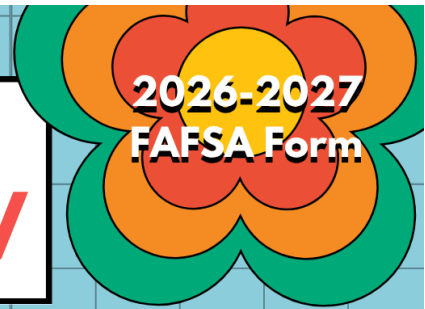

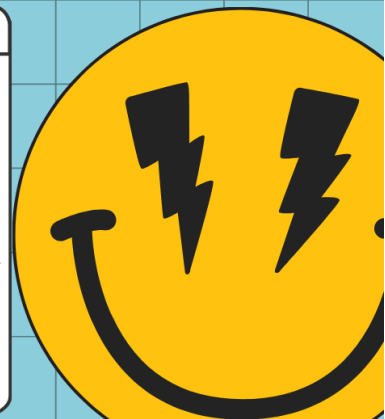
