### AVID FOCUS

More Organizational Tools!

Have you thought about note-taking as an organizational tool? We do! Note-taking is explicitly modeled to students across content areas, so they have multiple opportunities to practice this skill and become independent. Independence is key, as students are given information that they need to organize in a way that they derive meaning and depth with the subject at hand.

This might look like 2 or 3 column notes. You might also see Venn Diagrams or other graphic organizers. It's important for students to not only take notes, but also to determine the best format to use in order to frame their thinking.

**At Home:** Have your child help make the grocery list, organizing it by areas of the store, food types, or even by aisle! Discuss how the silverware drawer (or cabinet, pantry, refrigerator) is organized and what would happen if it wasn't. Have your child compare 2 or more items, but be sure to have him/her state differences (contrast) as well. When an event happens, spend some time talking about the cause, not just the effect. List events in your child's life, then have him/her organize them chronologically. All of these ideas are real-life examples to build and reinforce organizational skills.
