Dear Families.


Next week is a short week; students do not have school on Wednesday 11/24, Thursday 11/25, or Friday 11/26.

This time of year we reflect on how thankful we are for so many things, and we are so thankful that you share your children with us every day! We appreciate everything you do as part of our community and your great support.



HOW DO YOU GET YOUR CHILD STARTED?

Matching

When matching your child with a mentor, we take into account the needs, personality, interests, and goals of both the child and the adult volunteer.

Activities

We host two free activities a month for all of our matches. We also have many partners in the community who provide activities for our matches for free and/or at a discounted cost.

Staff Support

Each match is supported by an assigned BBBS Match Support Specialist who will provide resources, guidance, and assurance for your child's match.



HOW DO I GET MY CHILD STARTED?

- Reside in the BBBSM service area
- Be between the ages of 7 and 14 at the time of enrollment
- Show a desire to be matched in the program.
- Have a custodial parent/guardian that will demonstrate a supportive and cooperative attitude toward BBBSM and abide by the Agency's policies and guidelines
- Be in the area for at least 12 months to make a commitment to the program
- Be able to meet with their mentor 2-4 times per month for a total of at least 4 hours per month

Emparejamiento

Organizamos dos actividades gratuitas al mes para todos nuestros emparejados. Nosotros también tenemos muchos negocios asociados en la comunidad que ofrecen actividades para nuestros emparejados gratis y / o a un costo reducido.

Personal de Apoyo

Cada emparejado será apoyado por un Especialista de Apoyo asignada por BBBS que brindará recursos, orientación y certeza durante el emparejamiento de su hijo.



¿COMO INSCRIBO A MI HIJO?

- Su hijo debe de vivir en el área de servicio de BBBSM.
- Su hijo debe de tener entre 7 y 14 años al momento de la inscripción.
- Su hijo debe mostrar un deseo de ser emparejado en el programa.
- Su hijo debe de tener un padre/tutor con custodia que demuestre una actitud de apoyo y cooperación hacia BBBSM y cumplir con las políticas y directivas de la Agencia.
- Su hijo debe de mantenerse en el área para poder comprometerse al programa por lo menos un año.
- Su hijo debe de poder reunirse con su mentor de 2 a 4 veces al mes.

Community Corner... Community Resources

The Coronavirus started in early 2020 and spread across the community, resulting in economic turmoil which has continued into the 2021-22 school year. The economic turmoil or recession has resulted in a lack of sufficient food and household goods because of limited financial resources. Below is a list of local Thanksgiving pantries that may benefit your family.

HEARTLAND HOPE MISSION ***Times and days are subject to change***

Thanksgiving food pantry. Use South Entrance. Please view website and Facebook for the most up-to-date information: http://heartlandhopemission.org/; https://www.facebook.com/HeartlandHopeMission/

No pre-registration necessary. Only one pantry per household. Thanksgiving food will be distributed during normal pantry hours. Families may choose a holiday meat based on availability.

Bring Photo ID for head of household and ID for each member of household. Must be eligible for a normal food pantry. Clients who receive a Thanksgiving pantry from another location will not be served a Thanksgiving pantry.

Open Door Mission

Our Thanksgiving Program is called Turkey N Fixin's. Beginning November 2nd, community members can come to the Timberlake Outreach Center, or the Council Bluffs Outreach Center and receive a turkey OR a ham, along with some other traditional Thanksgiving specific foods as a part of their once a month shopping time. Please note, we can only give one turkey OR one ham PER address. This Holiday Assistance Program will run Tuesdays – Saturdays Nov 2nd through Nov 24th. You will need to have a current piece of mail with you when you come.
