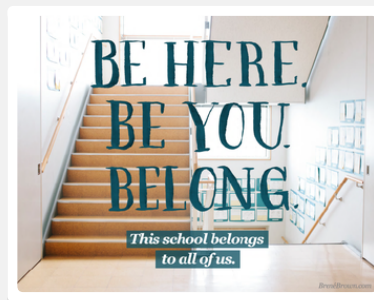
The parent survey will be open from **November 4, 2019** through **February 14, 2020**.

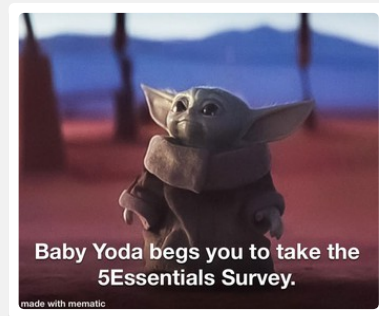

School Improvement Goals

Each year, schools create a School Improvement Plan (SIP) to help guide building goals. Lakewood Creek staff helps create the goals, works to achieve the goals, and monitors progress toward the goals.

For 2019-2020, our goals are:

- 1) At least thirty-two percent (combined) of current fourth- and fifth-grade students at Lakewood Creek Elementary School will meet or exceed standards on the 2020 IAR ELA Assessment, which is an increase of 5% over the 2019 IAR ELA Assessment.
- 2) By the 2019-2020 administration of 5Essentials, Lakewood Creek Elementary School will move from "Less Implementation" to "Average Implementation" in Collaborative Teachers.
- 3) By June 2020, general education teachers at Lakewood Creek will increase their knowledge and use of Tier 1 (differentiated) instruction for all students in their classrooms.
- 4) Expand staff cultural competency working with a diverse student body to increase comfort in engaging with conversations around culture, race, and difference. By June 2020, Lakewood Creek will have developed a schoolwide mission/vision for cultural competency.
