Dear Pleasanton Community,

We want to extend our sincere gratitude for your flexibility and patience during this challenging time. Your students, your families, our employees and the greater community are of utmost importance to us. As you know, the information we receive from the County is fluid and things are moving very quickly. Our priority continues to be the safety of our students and staff.

Earlier this afternoon, we received word from the Alameda County Public Health Department (ACPHD) that a six-county wide shelter in place at home [directive](#) was being implemented March 17, 2020 to April 7, 2020. Consequently, PUSD staff is being directed to head home in order to prepare for this extended period of isolation.

Due to the shelter in place and direction from the ACPHD, we are in the process of determining which essential functions will be continued to the benefit of students and staff and which functions will be considered non-essential during this period of time.
