The Family Resource Centers (FRCs) are pleased to provide free adult classes! Adult family members and caretakers of students registered at a TUSD school may attend any course offered at the FRCs at no cost. Courses focus on topics to strengthen family engagement and student success. Mental health, parenting skills, substance abuse, finances, college preparation, diet & nutrition, GED, and English are just some of the many subjects we cover.
