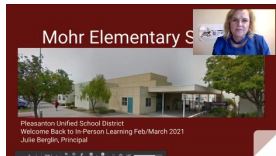
SCHOOL REOPENING INFORMATION

CHILD NUTRITION SERVICES (CNS) MEAL TEAM

Our Child Nutrition Services Team is preparing for hybrid reopening for Elementary Schools and would appreciate if you would complete a brief meal survey. Will you please take 2 - 3 minutes to complete their survey? [Meal Service Survey](#)
Before completing the survey here are some things you may like to know:

- Meals will be free for all children under 18 for the rest of the 2020/2021 school year
 - Guardians can still pick-up meals for students who are not enrolled via drive-thru locations
 - Students participating in distance learning are still welcome to pick-up via drive-thru locations
 - Student in the PM cohort may be dropped off 15 minutes early to eat school lunch on campus
 - All meals come with lunch/ breakfast following day.
 - We will not be selling any a la carte items, this includes water, soymilk, and second entrees
 - There is no meal application or income qualification required.
 - All students are welcome to participate.

NEWS FROM THE HEALTH ROOM! (MS. SONIA, HEALTH CLERK)

We have been preparing and are excited to have the kids back on campus! If you have a student who will have medication at school, please make sure that we have the correct [Medication Consent Form](#) for the current school year (**Prescribed & Over the Counter**), and that all of these guidelines have been met before bringing medication in:

- Students name must be on the box or bottle (keep label attached for prescription meds)
- Prescription medications must be in original container with current prescription label on container and match doctor's orders
- Consent form must be signed and stamped by the doctor, and signed by the parent/guardian

Parents/Guardians Kindergarten & First Grade

Physical Exam Form: ALL CHILDREN ENTERING FIRST GRADE NEED A COMPLETE HEALTH EXAMINATION. The examination is required by California State law. The examination helps uncover any hidden health problems which might keep your child from doing well in school. *Children may have the exam as early as 6 months before entering Kindergarten and up to 90 days after entering First Grade.*

Oral Health Form: California law (Education Code Section 49452.8) states your child must have a dental check-up by May 31 of his/her first year in public school. A California licensed dental professional operating within his scope of practice must perform the check-up and fill out Section 2 of the form. If your child had a dental check-up in the 12 months before he/she started school, ask your dentist to fill out Section 2. If you are unable to get a dental check-up for your child, fill out the waiver that is Section 3 of the form.
