This week we will be administering our Beginning of Year Measure of Academic Progress (MAP) Test on Monday and Tuesday. Please send your student to school with their Chromebook fully charged *and* send the charger. If your student does not have a Chromebook, a loaner will be provided as this test is only available by computer.

Mr. Neal (CHS Principal) and Mr. Leek (BHS Principal) asked us to pass the following information on to our students and parents this week:

Students are welcome and encouraged to attend all events and support CHS and BHS! Please be sure your student adheres to the following expectations:

- 1. Students must possess school ID (once it has been issued) and identify themselves by name and school/grade to BHS/CHS administration working the events if asked to do so.
