

TRIVIA ANSWERS

- 1) Over 1200 technology devices currently have outdated operating systems. Another 5,800 will need to be replaced in two years. For example, here at LC, we have (and use) a full iPad cart of 36 devices. Those iPads are no longer able to update software, so many apps are unable to be used. It will cost Lakewood Creek around \$10,000 to replace the iPads in the cart. This does not include the iPads each classroom uses. Likewise, our projectors and doc cameras are all nearing end of life. We are trying to replace those only as needed, but it is another ongoing expense coming out of our building budget.
- 2) SD308 serves over 18,000 students, including 25% low income, 8% English Learners, 14% students with IEPs, 56% white, 22% Hispanic, 9% black, 7% Asian, 5% multi-racial, and 67 different languages are spoken!
- 3) SD308 has an 88% teacher retention rate. Our staff is dedicated!
- 4) 75% of teachers in SD308 have a Master's Degree or higher!
- 5) Long before budget reductions became public, SD308 implemented many cost-cutting measures. Through cuts or increased revenue, \$3,049,000 was saved in 2016, \$3,750,486 in 2017, \$6,323,654 in 2018, and \$2,756,281 in 2019. That's over \$15 million!!!
