Dear Parents/Guardians,

On Tuesday, October 1, Guilford County Schools will administer the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT®) to eligible ninth, tenth, and eleventh grade students. The PSAT/NMSQT is cosponsored by the College Board and National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC). On the day of testing, your student should come to school on time **with a charged Chromebook and bring their chargers with them.** A bagged lunch will be provided.

In addition to serving as the entry point to the National Merit Scholarship Program, the PSAT/NMSQT is highly relevant to your child's future success because the test focuses on the skills and knowledge your child has learned in high school that will lead to success in college. Data from the PSAT/NMSQT can also be used to help our school understand your child's potential for success in Advanced Placement (AP) courses, plus data can also be used to qualify for college courses if attending an Early Middle College high school.
