You've taught them that communities work together for the greater good.

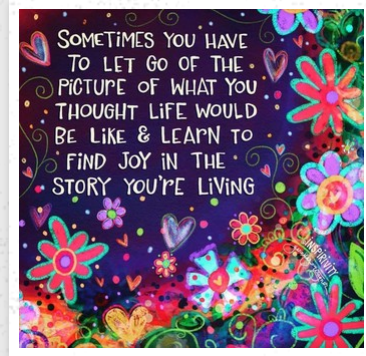
You've taught them the world is a good place. That even when circumstance are scary, people are good.
