Lynbrook High School Class of 2023 Prom, Graduation and Year-End Information

<u>Community Service</u> is a graduation requirement that must be completed by **Wednesday, May 31st.** Due to exemptions made in their freshmen and sophomore years, members of the Class of 2023 must complete 8 hours of community service in total. A list of students who have **completed** their community service will be posted in the cafeteria on May 1st. This will give an opportunity for students who still require hours to find opportunities throughout the month of May. Students who have not completed the total hours by May 31st cannot purchase a prom bid or walk at graduation. Blank community service cards are available in guidance. Please note that community service is handled through guidance. The Silver Cord Program, however, is handled by Mr. Garcia, and all applications should be returned to him by June 1st. Applications for the Silver Cord are available in the Curriculum Guide and in the Main Office.

<u>The Senior Summary Survey</u> will be available online in the "About Me" tab in Naviance starting on May 1st. Please write clearly and in full sentences as what you write will become part of a keepsake that you take home after graduation. This must be completed before May 19th, or you will not be able to purchase a Prom Ticket or Cap and Gown.

Locks and Lockers - All lockers must be cleaned out by the end of the school day, Monday, June 12th. All items left behind will be discarded. Locks must remain locked on your locker. Seniors with no lock on his or her locker will be charged an additional \$5.00 when caps and gowns are purchased at the Senior Breakfast.

- Graduation Rehearsal 10:30 AM at Marion Street (or in the HS gym if there is rain). You must be at graduation
 rehearsal so that you know where to sit and what to do. For those looking to make appointments, we generally
 rehearse for about 45 minutes. Please plan accordingly.

Senior Prom – Thursday Evening, June 22nd

- Only seniors who, along with one of their parents, attend one of the two evening pre-prom meetings (May 23rd or May 30th) <u>and</u> who have earned a minimum of 16.5 credits are eligible to attend the Senior Prom.
- All LHS seniors attending the prom must sign and return the Prom Contract, which will be distributed at the evening pre-prom meetings. They will be collected at the end of each evening session.
- Prom tickets will be sold Tuesday June 6th and Wednesday June 7th during all lunch periods and immediately after school. We anticipate the cost being \$40-\$45/ticket, payable in CASH ONLY.
- When purchasing a ticket, students must have the name of a parent, address, and emergency contact number for both them and their guest. Students must also create table arrangements of 10-12 people.
- All LHS seniors are responsible for their own behavior and the behavior of their guests.
- The Village Pre-Prom Celebration sponsored by the Lynbrook Chamber of Commerce begins at 5:00 PM on Thursday, June 22nd. This is a wonderful Lynbrook tradition, and we urge parents to stay and shop/eat on Atlantic Avenue after the event to show our support.
- The Prom begins at 7:00 PM at The Milleridge Inn North in Jericho you will not be permitted to leave the prom until 11:30 PM at the earliest. All students must bring their prom ticket to gain entry.

HS Graduation – Friday, June 23rd

- Takes place at 6:00 PM @ Marion Street or the High School Gym (if the weather is an issue).
- Seniors must arrive by 5:15 PM to line up and receive instructions.
- If there is a threat of rain on Friday, each graduate will receive 6 tickets for the HS Gym plus 1 for the Auditorium when caps and gowns will be distributed at the senior breakfast.
- A ParentLink phone message will be sent by 3:00 p.m. on Friday, June 23rd, if graduation needs to be moved to the High School Gym.
- Graduation packets, including diplomas, will be distributed to the students immediately after the ceremony.
- Due to noise sensitivities among the student body, please refrain from using airhorns during the ceremony so that all members of the Class of 2023 may celebrate this event together.
