PSAT scores are coming the week of December 10th

Scores are available on line this year. You will receive your PSAT Test Book in advisement after you return from Winter Break. To view your scores go to: <https://studentscores.collegeboard.org>

If you have a College Board account, sign in using your user name and password and then click "Sign In" to be taken to your scores.

If you don't have a College Board account, you can create one by clicking "Sign Up" and entering the required information. You should use the same information you provided on the PSAT answer sheet.

From your computer, you can print your online score report by clicking the View Details button, then clicking Download Report in the top right corner. This report gives you detailed information about your test.

If you wish to view videos on Understanding Your PSAT/NMSQT Scores or How to Link Your Scores to Khan Academy, go to the Marietta High School Webpage. You will click on the Counseling Tab and look for Testing on the drop down menu. Scroll down the page until you see PSAT.
