Dear Eisenhower School Community,

First and foremost, we are thankful for your ongoing support and encouragement of Eisenhower School staff and District leaders as we collectively work together to ensure that the future of the school is bright.

The preparation work in advance of the June 22 Eisenhower Career Fair is well underway. The District's Human Resources team have already pre-scheduled 16 interviews with highly-qualified candidates attending the job fair event. We are optimistic that the fair will be fruitful in our pursuit of hiring great teachers for next school year.

Amidst all of the planning for next school year, Dr. Mansukhani shared her reflection about her leadership role in the Eisenhower School community with District leaders. After considerable thought, Dr. Mansukhani submitted a request to the District on June 13 to move from the role of principal of Eisenhower Elementary School to another position in the District. Dr. Mansukhani will remain with the Wauwatosa School District in a role designated within the Division of Academic Performance. Specifically, she will serve as an Academic Specialist in the District. Dr. Mansukhani is a promising educational leader and we are pleased to be able to support her continued leadership growth.

The timing of Dr. Mansukhani's request for a transfer does not position the District to engage in a traditional search process for the next principal. Fortunately, the District has a talented and prepared school leader who is ready for the principalship. We are pleased to announce that Mr. Jordan Stein has been appointed as the next principal of Eisenhower Elementary School.

Mr. Stein is currently an Associate Principal at Wauwatosa East High School and has served in his current position for the past three years. Mr. Stein has led efforts at Wauwatosa East in maintaining the positive student culture and climate.

Prior to being appointed as an Associate Principal, Mr. Stein was a special education teacher at Wauwatosa East High School. He has extensive experience in managing individual education plans and interventions for students. As a graduate of Wauwatosa East, Mr. Stein is a long-time dedicated member of the Wauwatosa community. Recently, Mr. Stein completed a rigorous interview process to select the next principal of Wauwatosa East High School. While he did not emerge as the selected candidate, he demonstrated that (1) he is prepared and ready to lead a school and (2) he is one of the most talented emerging school leaders in the Milwaukee area.

It is increasingly important that the District is able to verify effective leadership experience in prospective candidates. The principalship is an important position and a prerequisite is that leaders are ready from day one. Mr. Stein meets all of the qualifications that we deem necessary for the next principal at Eisenhower. Mr. Stein is excited about this opportunity. He is looking forward to meeting members of the Eisenhower School community.

Mr. Stein recognizes the need to establish a collaborative partnership with the school community. Staff members and families can expect a message from Mr. Stein in the coming days.
