## Free Programs

**Full STEAM Ahead!** — Uses Opening Minds through the Arts (OMA), STEM curriculum, and highly-engaged teachers.

Students also receive ELA and Math instruction in small groups.

**Freshman Academy** — Supports incoming 9th grade students to transition from middle school to high school while building math, reading and study skills.

**High School Credit Recovery** — For current high school students looking to catch up and graduate with their class! Held in-person at all schools.
