#### **AUID FOCUS**

Does your child have a designated Study Space?

Just like a desk, binder, or backpack are organizational tools, identifying potential learning spaces that are accessible after school hours is valuable as well. Here at school, we explicitly teach various ways to keep spaces and materials organized, along with the benefits of doing so.

At Home: If your child has a designated Study Space, ask him/her if it is an ideal location for work. If you don't already have a space, think about location, lighting, sound, seating, supplies, and time. Have your child spend a few minutes in several different spaces to notice what they see or hear when in that area. Who or what is around the space? What might distract them? What feelings do they have when in this space? Are all supplies readily accessible? Is there enough light as it gets dark in the evening?
