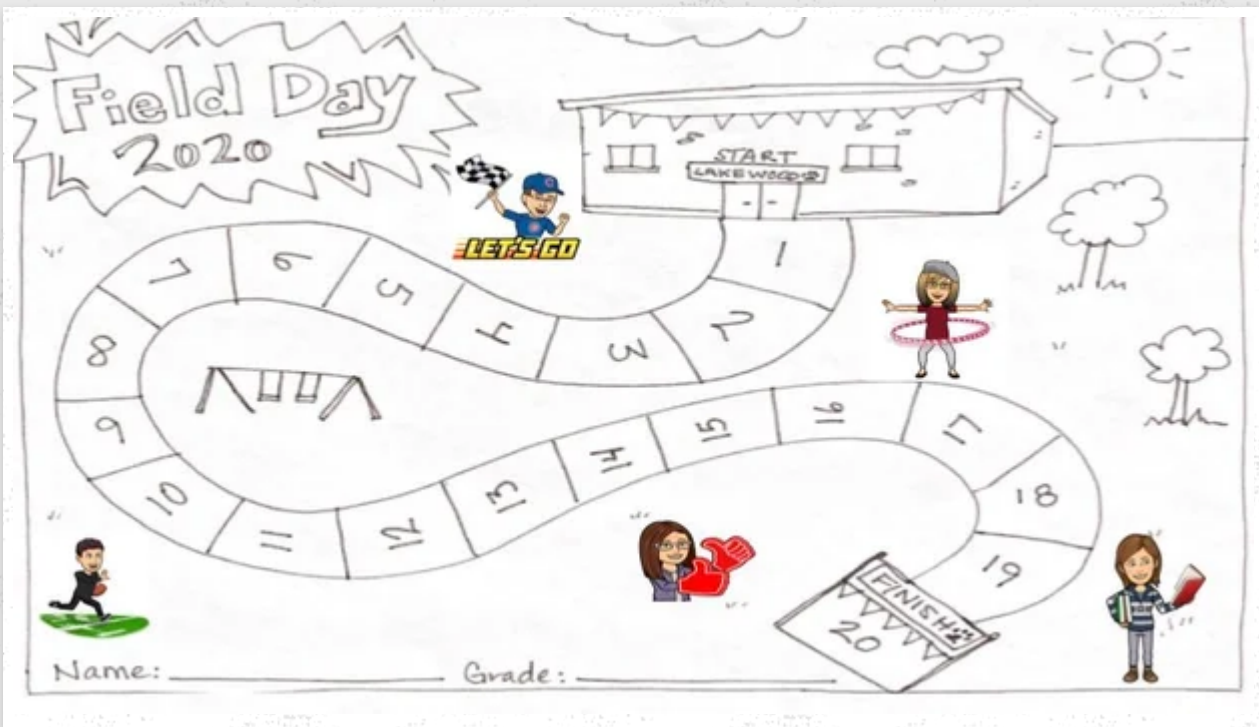
gift card. We will not be able to accept physical gifts for staff. Many of our staff members will not even be back in the building until fall.

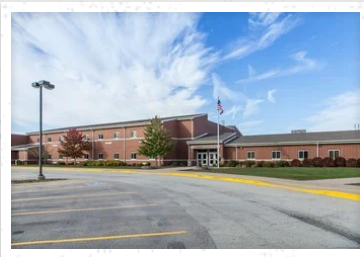
