Food Pantries at the Family Resource Centers (FRCs)

Did you know there are four food pantries located throughout Tucson Unified School District? There are! The four Family Resource Centers in the district operate a food pantry through a partnership with the Community Food Bank of Southern Arizona. All food pantries are fully licensed through the Pima County Health Department, and the FRC staff are trained in handling food items.



Students and families experiencing food insecurity, for any reason, can visit a Family Resource Center for food assistance. All pantries are stocked with non-perishable food items from the Community Food Bank. Food items often include rice, beans, pasta, pasta sauce, tuna, canned fruits, canned vegetables, cereal, and peanut butter. The food

The Catalina and Palo Verde Family Resource Centers participate in the grocery rescue program which allows them to rescue and distribute perishable food items from local stores. Perishable items such as meats, dairy products, frozen meals, and salads are stored in commercial refrigerators and freezers.




FEEDING
