

Community Resources

This school year the Community Corner is going to mainly focus on community resources. The Coronavirus started in early 2020 and spread across the community, resulting in economic turmoil which has continued into the 2021-22 school year. The economic turmoil or recession has resulted in a lack of sufficient food and household goods because of limited

financial resources. Below is a list of local pantries that may benefit your family.
