Procedures for Parent – Student Drop Off and Pick Up

The loop in front of the school is designated as the Pick-up/Drop-off area. There is no parking in the loop during morning drop-off or afternoon pick-up at dismissal.

You may park your car in the designated spots in our parking lot. The speed limit in the parking lot is <u>5 MPH</u>. You may also park in the dirt across the street from the school, but we ask that you use the crosswalk to cross Lightning at all times. We would like our students to do that always, and parent modeling will help support safe student choices.

We Need Your Help – Dismissal Procedures

It is district policy that all students leave our campus/ playground at the time of dismissal. Students may not stay to play on the playground, as there is no supervision for their safety. We require that students leave the Borman campus at dismissal and either go home/ babysitter or to the School Age Program/ Youth Center.
