Marin County Public Health is prioritizing access to vaccines for youth, age 12 to 15 years of age, now that the Pfizer Covid-19 vaccine has been approved for use in California. **All vaccine sites are FREE and insurance is not required. All vaccination options in Marin can be found on getvaccinatedmarin.org.**

Below are a list of sites with prioritized access for youth age 12 to 15 years of age:

OPTION ONE: Appointments at Larkspur Ferry Terminal drive-through site:

Steps to access an appointment at the Larkspur Ferry, which is open Sunday through Thursday, 11:00 AM to 7:00 PM:

1. Go to <https://myturn.ca.gov/>
2. Select your preferred language and click "Find an appointment"
3. Answer the questions
4. Enter your address or Zip Code and click "Continue"
5. Locate the Larkspur Ferry Terminal, listed as "Larkspur Ferry Terminal Marin - CURATIVE", among the list of choices. Click the link to be directed to Curative's website and follow the remaining steps to secure an appointment.

Insider tips: When browsing MyTurn, only use the "back" or "forward" buttons for navigation. Clicking "refresh" on your browser will take you back to step one. If you do not see Larkspur right away, try clicking back and then forward, or opening in a new tab/window.

OPTION TWO - Safeway Vaccine Clinic at Miller Creek Middle School:

Marin County Public Health is teaming up with Safeway and Marin County Office of Education to offer two vaccine clinics dedicated to youth 12-17 years old and their families. These clinics will take place at Miller Creek Middle School, 2255 Las Gallinas Ave, San Rafael, CA 94903 on:

- Saturday, May 15
- Saturday, May 22

Depending on demand, Safeway will open more appointments for each day, so check back if you don't see appointments right away! Walk-ins will be accommodated as space allows.

To schedule an appointment:

1. Go to www.mhealthsystem.com/marinschool
2. Click the link to confirm that you are eligible for vaccine
3. Click the "Two Dose Covid Vaccine Appt. - Dose 1" button
4. Choose May 15th or May 22nd
5. Choose appointment time

6. Complete information on the student or family member who will be receiving the vaccine
7. Follow prompts to complete appointment
8. Fill out Safeway's COVID-19 Immunization Consent Form prior to your appointment

OPTION THREE: Appointments at Curative Mobile Van

If you are unable to secure an appointment via the Larkspur Ferry Terminal, you may try to obtain an appointment with the Curative Mobile Van:

OPTION FOUR: Walk-up appointments at select Marin County Schools

Marin County Public Health is working with select Marin County schools to offer vaccination opportunities on campus. Appointments are not required, and preference will be given to students and family members enrolled at the school site. For students who are enrolled at the host school site, students may be given a vaccine without parent or guardian present, if they have a completed and signed consent form on file at the school. Parents may also accompany their student(s) and complete the consent form on site. Information on these school site based clinics will be shared by the host schools and districts.

OPTION FIVE: Other Options

- If you do not have access to the internet or an internet enabled device, you can call (833) 641-1988 for help with scheduling an appointment at the Larkspur Ferry Terminal or most vaccine sites in Marin.

Reminders for your Appointment:

- If possible, bring a Photo ID (or proof of date of birth)
 - Birth Certificate
 - Student ID Card
 - Passport or Photo ID
 - Report Card or other document from school with Date of Birth
 - For schools that are hosting vaccination clinics, they may print out an exported report of all students 12 years and older as of date of vaccine clinic
- Arrive no earlier than 10 minutes before your appointment time
- Wear a t-shirt or blouse that allows easy access to upper arm
- Do NOT attend clinic if you are feeling unwell or experiencing COVID symptoms
- For Curative locations (Larkspur Ferry and Mobile)
 - Minors age 12 - 17 should be accompanied by a parent or guardian
 - Bring an insurance or medical card if you have one (uninsured individuals are welcome)
- Safeway Pharmacy
 - Bring an insurance or medical card if you have one (uninsured individuals are welcome)
 - Must be accompanied by parent or guardian
