Dear Parents and Students,

Included with this letter is the bus schedule for your area. In developing these schedules, we have tried to anticipate traffic situations and other problems which could delay buses, but it is impossible to foresee every difficulty which may arise. There are bound to be some late buses and missed pickups during the first two days of school.

If your child encounters a major problem, please contact your school, Millard Transportation Office at 715-8474, or Student Transportation of America (STA) at 402-884-4222.

Please go over the following safety rules with your child.

BEFORE BOARDING

- a. Be at the bus stop 5 minutes before the designated time.
- b. Stay out of the street while waiting for the bus.
- c. Stay away from the bus until it stops, and do not move toward the bus until the door opens.

WHILE RIDING

- a. Sit quietly and refrain from rowdy conduct.
- b. Act as you would in a classroom, no loud talking.
- c. Ask permission to open windows and keep hands and heads inside the bus.
- d. Be completely quiet when bus stops at railroad crossing.
- e. Obey the bus driver.
- f. Items not allowed in school will not be allowed on the bus.
- g. Never tamper with the bus or any part of its equipment.

WHEN LEAVING THE BUS

- a. Wait until bus comes to a complete stop before trying to get off.
- b. Quickly clear the unloading zone as students exit the bus.
- c. Cross at least 10 feet in front of bus, looking both ways.
- d. Do not cross in back of the bus.

Only students assigned may ride the bus. If you wish to have a friend come over to the student home, please make other arrangements for transportation.

All buses are equipped with a video monitoring system in front of the bus and can view the students during the trip to and from school serving as a "second pair of eyes" for the bus driver. The system also will provide the school administration with support information as to unsafe situations on the bus.

Damage to seats, windows and other equipment must be paid by the offender.


Bus discipline is a shared responsibility of students, parents, drivers and school principals. It is imperative that strict rules be enforced to ensure the safety of students. Procedures for handling discipline on school buses are the same as those used in the classroom.

A SCHOOL BUS DANGER ZONE



The Danger Zone is the space all around your bus. It goes out 10 feet. The school bus driver cannot see you in this zone. He or she cannot see you around the wheels either. It is a very dangerous to be in this area.

Why is it called the Danger Zone?

If your bus driver cannot see you, he may hit you. It has happened before to others who have been injured or killed. You must be very careful whenever you get on or off the bus.

Getting On the Bus

You must wait for the bus in a place that is safe. Playing around the bus stop is not safe. You could be hurt. Get on the bus in single file. Be nice. Don't push or shove. Use the handrails.

If something drops under the bus, leave it there. Let your school bus driver or another adult get it for you.

Getting Off the Bus

Get off the bus in single file. Don't push or shove. Take a least 10 Giant Steps away from the bus. This is about 10 feet.

Stop, listen. Look left, right and left again. Take 10 Giant Steps away from the bus. Stay away from the bus as you head for home. If you have to cross the road, cross in front of the bus, and remember these things:

- 1. Look at the driver. You should always see the driver.
- 2. Make sure the driver sees you and you see him or her.
- 3. Take 10 Giant Steps ahead of the bus.
- 4. Wait for the driver to signal you when it is safe to cross.
- 5. To be sure that it is safe, look left, right and left again before crossing.
- 6. Never cross behind the bus

Use this time to have your child familiar with where their stop location is. Have your child aware of stranger danger. Does your child know what to do? Does he or she know his address, phone number, a safe home to go to in your neighborhood?
