REQUIREMENTS**

All students who wish to purchase a parking permit must meet the following criteria based on the **previous semester**:

- Minimum **accumulated** 2.5 overall, weighted GPA.
- On track to graduate based on 9th grade entry date.
- No outstanding debts, fines, textbooks, uniforms etc.
- No out of school suspensions (OSS).
- No more than (3) days of ISS/MSLC served for behavioral or attendance referrals.
- No more than six (6) full days of absences (unexcused & excused).
- No more than nine (9) tardies to school (unexcused & excused).
