Meet your teachers

For those families who I have yet to meet, my name is Michael Hayden and I am the orchestra teacher at East High School. This year marks my 10th year at Tosa East and my 20th year teaching orchestra. Prior to Wauwatosa, I taught orchestra and music technology in Hales Corners, Whitefish Bay, Tempe, AZ and Littleton, CO. I hold degrees in music and music education from the University of Colorado at Boulder and Northwestern University, and am Nationally Board Certified in orchestra. I live in the Roosevelt Neighborhood with my two daughters and am married to Longfellow's own (and my claim to fame), Ms. Roz.

This year we are excited to add another orchestra teacher, Ms. Dana Federmeier (also at Longfellow), who will be with us several days per week helping out with our four (that's right, four) sections of orchestra. Ms. Federmeier has previously taught in Waukesha, New Berlin, and is a highly sought after festival judge and state honors orchestra sectional coach. She holds degrees in music education and educational leadership from UW-Whitewater and UW-Milwaukee. She lives in the Washington neighborhood with her husband, two daughters, and two dogs.

Concert Attire

Musicians at Tosa East wear all black while performing. For returning students, there are no changes from previous years. For those new to Tosa East Orchestra, you can find a more detailed description [HERE](#).

Orchestra Fee

This year's orchestra fee of \$50 will be added directly to Infinite Campus and can be paid online, similar to other school/registration related fees. *This should be available in Infinite Campus the last week of August.* For those families new to East orchestra, we strive to offer the most comprehensive music education possible. The orchestra fee goes directly towards solo and ensemble registrations, guest performers, composer talks, commissioned pieces of music, transportation to/from special events, and in recent years, a consistent stream of instrument coaches to help our student musicians (including several members of the Milwaukee Symphony). While the orchestra fee does help finance these student opportunities, it is not the intent to create any barriers or financial hardships to participate in orchestra at Wauwatosa East High School. If you have questions, concerns, or need assistance with the orchestra fee, please do not hesitate to contact Mr. Hayden. Finally, students can choose to participate in our annual late fall fundraiser to offset the orchestra fee. Details regarding the fundraiser will be sent home in October.

School Cello / Bass Rentals

East Orchestra will continue to be able to offer all students playing the cello or string bass an instrument to play while they're at school. These instruments stay in the orchestra room and are shared by other students during other class periods. There is a \$25 per year rental fee which will be added to your child's Infinite Campus account towards the end of September. **No action needed at this time.** Cello and bass students are expected to have an additional instrument at home to practice.

LA Performance Tour

This fall, East Orchestra will travel to California to record and learn about the LA movie/music industry. We'll also spend one day at Disneyland and an evening at the beach. As a reminder, our final trip meeting will take place on Wednesday, September 17th at 6:30pm in the East Theatre. Most information for our LA trip has been emailed through the MyGateway system. Fiddle Club

As you may have heard, East has a before school Irish/Celtic/Bluegrass/Fiddle ensemble. This is a primarily student run group that is open to all students in orchestra. Typical meeting time is Wednesday at 7:15am.
