**RECEIPT AND OPENING OF PROPOSALS:** Sealed proposals for the work described below will be received by the Iowa Great Lakes Sanitary District, 303 28<sup>th</sup> Street, Milford, IA 51351, until 2:00 p.m. on December 7, 2021, at which time the bids will be opened and publicly read.

**DESCRIPTION OF WORK:** The work includes the construction of approximately:

- A. Installation of new primary and secondary clarifier drives provided by Iowa Great Lakes Sanitary District.
- B. Rehabilitation to the existing three (3) primary and three (3) secondary clarifier tanks.
- C. Rehabilitation to the existing three (3) primary and three (3) secondary clarifier mechanisms and bridge.
- D. Electrical work associated with new clarifier drives.

together with numerous related items of work, all in accordance with Plans and Specifications.

**COMMENCEMENT AND COMPLETION OF WORK:** Work shall commence upon approval of the contract by the Board of Trustees and as stated in the Notice to Proceed. All work under the Contract must be complete within 240 calendar days after receipt of the Notice to Proceed.

**BID SECURITY:** A bid security as defined by Iowa Code Chapter 26.8 and in the amount of not less than 5 percent of the total amount bid, drawn in favor of Iowa Great Lakes Sanitary District shall accompany each bid.

**PREFERENCE OF PRODUCTS AND LABOR:** Preference shall be given to domestic construction materials by the contractor, in performance of the contract and further, by virtue of statutory authority, preference will be given to products and provisions grown and coal produced within the State of Iowa, and to Iowa domestic labor, to the extent lawfully required under Iowa statutes. Failure to submit a fully completed Bidder Status Form with the bid may result in the bid being deemed nonresponsive and rejected.

**SALES TAX EXEMPTION:** The bidder shall not include sales tax in the bid. The Iowa Great Lakes Sanitary District will distribute tax exemption certificates and authorization letters to the Contractor and all subcontractors who are identified. The Contractor and subcontractor may make copies of the tax exemption certificates and provide a copy to each supplier providing construction materials. These tax exemption certificates and authorization letters are applicable only for this specific project under the Contract.

**OWNER'S RIGHTS RESERVED:** The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any irregularities and informalities therein and to award the Contract to other than the lowest bidder if, in their discretion, the interest of the Owner would be best served thereby.
