

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received by the General Manager of **Winterset Municipal Utilities, Winterset, Iowa**, at the City Office at 124 W Court Avenue, Winterset, IA 50273 before **1:30 P.M.**, on **December 15, 2021**, for the generator installation work at the Winterset Municipal Utilities Power Plant. At said time and place bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids will be considered by the Utility Board at its meeting at 8:30 A.M. on December 20, 2021 at the Utilities Office at 321 N. John Wayne Drive, Winterset, IA 50273. The Utility Board may award the contract at said meeting or at such other time and place as shall then be announced.

The general nature of the work on which bids will be received consists of the installation of two (2) diesel-fired generating units and auxiliary equipment.

The above work shall be in accordance with the specifications and proposed form of contract now on file in the offices of Winterset Municipal Utilities, Winterset, Iowa, by this reference made a part hereof, as though fully set out and incorporated herein.

Each bid shall be made out on a blank form furnished by the Utility and must contain either (1) a cashier's check or draft or check or share draft certified and drawn on a solvent State or National bank, in an amount equal to ten (10) percent of the amount of the Bid; or (2) a bid bond executed by a corporation authorized to contract as a surety in the State of Iowa, in an amount not less than ten (10) percent of the amount of the Bid. The bid security shall be made payable to Winterset Municipal Utilities. The bid security must not contain any conditions either in the body or as an endorsement thereon. Such bid security shall be forfeited to the Utility as liquidated damages in the event the successful bidder fails or refuses to enter into a contract within fifteen (15) days after the award of contract and post a satisfactory Performance Bond.

The sealed envelope containing the bid shall be clearly marked "BID ENCLOSED – GENERATOR INSTALLATION WORK AT THE WINTERSET MUNICIPAL UTILITIES POWER PLANT" on the outside of the envelope.

Payment to the Contractor for said construction work will be made from cash on hand or such other funds that legally may be used or obtained for such purposes. Estimates will be paid monthly by the City to the Contractor in accordance with the following schedule:

Ninety-five percent (95%) upon certification of units completed; five percent (5%) thirty days after final completion and acceptance.

Construction may be started after the execution of the Construction Agreement (the Contract) and the issuance of the Notice to Proceed. See the "Construction Schedule" of the Technical Specifications for special instructions relating to this project.

By virtue of statutory authority, a preference will be given to products and provisions grown, and coal produced within the State of Iowa, and preference shall be given to Iowa domestic labor in the construction of said improvements. The Owner will, in evaluating Bids, consider the requirements of the resident bidder preference law, and allow such preferences to resident bidders as are required to be allowed under State Law. Bidder shall, when submitting a Bid, furnish an executed Bidder Status Form for the Owner to use when applying the preference law. Failure to submit a fully completed Bidder Status Form with the bid may result in the bid being deemed nonresponsive and rejected.

Winterset Municipal Utilities reserves the right to defer acceptance of any proposal for a period not to exceed forty-five (45) days after the date proposals are received and no proposal may be withdrawn during this period. The Utility also reserves the right to waive irregularities, reject any or all bids, and enter into such contract as it shall be deemed to be in the best interest of the Utility.
