Job summary:

Under general direction, performs field inspections of all commercial, industrial, institutional and residential structures for compliance with related codes and regulations. Prescribes action for conformance to codes and standards. Assists in the planning and implementation of owner-occupied and rental housing rehabilitation programs.

Minimum qualifications:

Associate degree from an educational institution accredited by a DOE recognized accreditation body or equivalent experience in a related field required. Individuals are required to hold International Code Council Residential Building Inspector (B1) certification within 12 months of hire. Certified Lead Inspector/Risk Assessor certification is required within one year of hire if the position works within Neighborhood Services division. Valid driver's license with satisfactory driving record required. Must be 18 years of age per Iowa Code 92.8. Must pass criminal background check

Preferred qualifications:

Bachelor's degree in a related field from an educational institution accredited by a DOE recognized accreditation body or three years' experience in construction/building trades preferred. Experience in construction/building trades preferred. Additional International Code Council certifications such as Commercial Building Inspector (B2), Property Maintenance and Housing Inspector (64), or other Residential, Commercial or Plans Examiner certifications (B3, M1-3, E1-3, P1-3), or the ability to obtain such certification within 12 months of hire is highly desired.
