Now Accepting Applications from Certified Candidates

The Sheldon Police Department is accepting applications from certified law enforcement officers for a full-time police officer position. Starting wage for lateral transfer police officers after July 1, 2022, is \$54,731 to \$64,602 depending on experience. The top pay for police officers is \$67,201 after completion of probation and five years of law enforcement experience. The City of Sheldon offers an excellent benefit package. Officers must reside within 25 miles of Sheldon within one year of hire.

Applicants must meet the minimum hiring standards as set by the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy Council and Iowa Administrative Code 501. All interested applicants will be required to apply by 4:30 PM on Friday June 3, 2022. Applications can be picked up in person or downloaded from the City of Sheldon website. All required documents must be included with the completed application to be considered.

Applicants who are not ILEA certified must undergo physical agility testing and written POST testing tentatively scheduled June 9, 2022. Final details will be confirmed with applicants who are invited to continue with the testing process.
