FUNCTION:

The City of Ankeny is accepting applications for Police Officer at the Ankeny Police Department.

Starting salary is **\$28.16 per hour** for non-certified increasing to **\$31.29 per hour** following graduation from the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy, or up to **\$36.22 per hour** for certified officers. The City offers excellent benefits and paid time off. [Recruitment Brochure](#)

The physical agility test and Police Officer Selection Test (POST) will be administered to all qualified applicants - *Dates TBD and more information will be emailed to qualified candidates at a later time.*

Interested candidates should complete a City of Ankeny employment application online and attach a cover letter and resume.

Current certified law enforcement officers with appropriate sworn experience as stated below are eligible for lateral transfer if they meet the following conditions:

- Completion of 12 months (1 year) post academy service shall be paid at Step 2 (\$32.85/hour)
- Completion of 24 months (2 years) post academy service shall be paid at Step 3 (\$34.49/hour)
- Completion of more than 36 months (3+ years) post academy service shall be paid at Step 4 (\$36.22/hour)

Signing Bonus: New employees who at time of hire are currently law enforcement officers shall receive a \$5,000 signing bonus.

Contract Reimbursement: The City of Ankeny will pay 50% of the balance due on their employment contract with their latest city/county/state employer not to exceed \$2,000.

PRINCIPAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Primary function is to enforce local, state and federal laws and ordinances; to patrol assigned areas; and to do skilled police work in the investigation of alleged criminal offenses and juvenile cases.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND SKILLS:

To be eligible you must have graduated from high school or an equivalent, and be able to meet minimum standards for Iowa Law Enforcement officers as indicated by the [Iowa Law Enforcement Academy](#).

You must also be able to maintain a valid motor vehicle operator's license issued by the State of Iowa. No OWI convictions within the last five years. No more than three convictions for moving violations within any 12-month period over the last five years. Must be able to obtain an Iowa Professional Permit to carry weapons. The police department will only hire non-tobacco users.

Post offer physical, drug screen, psychological exam, and polygraph required.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

- May require working for extended periods outdoors in adverse weather conditions.
