The Bid Bond may be forfeited and the proceeds retained as liquidated damages if the bidder fails to execute a contract or file acceptable performance bonds or provide an acceptable certificate of insurance within fifteen (15) calendar days after the acceptance of his proposal by resolution of the Airport Authority. No bidder may withdraw a proposal within ninety (90) days after the date set for opening bids.

The right is reserved, as **Southeast Iowa Regional Airport Authority** may require, to reject any and all bids and to waive any informality in the bids received.

All Contractor(s) and subcontractor(s) are required to obtain tax exemption certificates from the **Southeast Iowa Regional Airport Authority, Iowa** for this project. These tax exemption certificates are only for use on this specific project as covered under the Contract. Before final payment will be made on this project, the Contractor(s) and subcontractor(s) shall provide lien waivers as required in the Specifications.
