



RESERVE POLICE OFFICER

The City of Cedar Falls is accepting applications to test for Reserve Police Officer. Applicants must be a minimum of 21 yrs. old, possess a high school diploma or equivalent, have a valid Iowa Driver's License with good driving record, be an Iowa resident, and successfully pass a background check and post-offer Police Officer physical and drug screen.

Reserve Officers are provided with necessary training, equipment and uniforms and work with and serve in a voluntary capacity to supplement career Officers. A monetary stipend is provided after 2 yrs. of service. The City is seeking applicants who are satisfied with their current career but have the desire to volunteer their time to the citizens of Cedar Falls.
