Forklift and backhoe certification within probationary period. Satisfactory driving record. Valid State of Iowa commercial driver's license instruction permit upon first day in position. Valid State of Iowa Class A commercial driver's license with air brake endorsements within 6 months of hire. Meet federal drug testing requirements. Requires a pre-employment drug screen. Must be 18 years of age. Must pass criminal background check.

High school education or G.E.D. and seven to twelve months of related experience or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.
