The Waverly Civil Service Commission is accepting applications to establish an eligibility list for appointment as Police Officer. This is a career opportunity with a 17-officer department that provides service to a community of over 10,000 residents.

Applicants selected for testing will undergo written examination, physical fitness testing, interview, psychological testing, comprehensive background investigation, medical testing, and drug testing.

Police Officer salary range is \$68,599 - \$80,262.

ILEA certified peace officers are eligible to receive a \$6,000 hiring incentive (50% upon hire and 50% after field training). The physical agility test and written exam is waived for current ILEA Certified Officers in good standing.

Applications will be accepted until 4:00 p.m., Friday August 28, 2024. Mandatory testing will be held Saturday September 21, 2024.
