At such time and place, the City of Keokuk shall also hold a Public Hearing on the proposed Plans, Specifications, form of Contract and estimate of cost for the construction of said improvements hereinafter described in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 384, Code of lowa, at 5:30pm on the 3rd of July, 2025 at 501 Main Street. At the hearing, the City of Keokuk will receive and consider any objections made by any interested party, to the Plans and Specifications, proposed form of Contract, and the estimate of the cost for the project.

All bids must be filed with the Airport Manager on or before the time herein set. All bids shall be made on forms furnished by the City of Keokuk and obtained from McClure Engineering Company and must be enclosed in a separate sealed envelope and plainly identified. Each bid shall be accompanied by a Bid Bond, Certified Check, Certified Share Draft or Cashier's Check in a separate envelope in an amount equal to five (5%) of the total amount of the bid. If Bid Bond is submitted, it must be on the form provided with the Contract Documents. The Certified Check, Certified Share Draft or Cashier's Check shall be drawn on a bank or Credit Union in Iowa or a bank or Credit Union chartered under the laws of the United States of America and payable to the City of Keokuk as security that if awarded a contract, the bidder will enter into a contract at the prices bid and furnish the required performance and payment bonds and certificates of Insurance.

The Certified Check, Certified Share Draft or Cashier's Check may be cashed, or the Bid Bond forfeited, and the proceeds retained as liquidated damages if the bidder fails to execute a contract or file acceptable performance bonds or provide an acceptable certificate of insurance within fifteen (15) calendar days after the acceptance of his proposal by resolution of the Commission. No bidder may withdraw a proposal within ninety (90) days after the date set for opening bids.

The right is reserved, as the **City of Keokuk** may require, to reject any and all bids and to waive any informality in the bids received.

All Contractor(s) and subcontractor(s) are required to obtain tax exemption certificates from the **City of Keokuk** for this project. These tax exemption certificates are only for use on this specific project as covered under the Contract. Before final payment is made on this project, the Contractor(s) and subcontractor(s) shall provide lien waivers as required in the Specifications.

The Contractor shall have 90 days to complete all work from the date they initiate work on the terminal building. It is anticipated that the Contractor could start work on September 8th, 2025. The Contractor will be issued a Notice-to-Proceed from the City before any work can begin. The Contractor shall finish all work no later than February 28th, 2026. \$250 per calendar day will be charged to the contractor as liquidated damages for all days past the 90-day work period that work has not been completed. The Contactor will be given 14 days to complete final punch-list items once work has been completed. \$250 per calendar day will be charged to the contractor as liquidated damages for all days past the 14 day final closeout period that all work has not been completed.

This project is subject to the requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act, as amended. The Contractor is required to comply with wage and labor provisions and to pay minimum wages in accordance with the schedule of wage rates established by the United States Department of Labor.

This project is subject to the requirements of 49 CFR Part 26 Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Participation. The owner has established a contract goal of 1.04 percent participation for small business concerns owned and controlled by qualified disadvantaged business enterprises (DBE). The bidder shall make and document good faith efforts, as defined in Appendix A of 49 CFR Part 26, to meet the established goal.
