- Develop a sustainable funding model through various revenue streams and sponsorships continue the Entrepreneurial Community Navigator position and lowa's West Coast Initiative's mission.
- Expand outreach to K-12 and college students/educators to foster entrepreneurship education and increase involvement in the local business ecosystem.
- Collaborate with stakeholders to share information, submit grant reports, and track success metrics to ensure ongoing program effectiveness.
