All proposals shall be accompanied by either a bid bond on the "Proposal Bid Bond" form contained in the proposal, executed by a corporate surety company satisfactory to the Keokuk Municipal Waterworks, or a bank cashier's check, an irrevocable letter of credit or a properly certified check payable to the Keokuk Municipal Waterworks for not less than 5 percent (5%) of the amount bid, or for the amount listed in the specifications.

The Keokuk Municipal Waterworks reserves the right to reject any or all proposals and to waive technicalities and reserves the right to determine the qualifications of any and all contractors to perform the work required under this contract.

No bid may be withdrawn after the time for opening of the bids is past.

Bidders are notified that not less than the prevailing wage rate as determined by the Davis Bacon Act shall be paid to all workmen performing work under this contract.

Bids may be held by the Keokuk Municipal Waterworks for a period not to exceed 60 days from the date of the opening of Bids for the purpose of reviewing the Bids and investigating the qualifications of Bidders, prior to awarding of the Contract.
