#### REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR STREETS REPAIR

The City of Williamsburg is requesting proposals on the repair of street pavement.

#### **Vendor Requirements**

Vendors must provide a certificate of insurance to the City with the following minimum requirements:

#### §10.009 MINIMUM INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS.

- (A) Individuals obtaining a license or permit requiring insurance shall have the following minimum liability and submit the certificate of insurance with the license or permit application prior to approval of such license or permit.
  - (1) Automobile liability: \$1,000,000 combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage.
  - (2) General liability insurance:
    - (a) \$1,000,000 each occurrence (combined bodily injury and property damage) premises/operations and products/completed operations;
    - (b) \$1,000,000 personal and advertising injury; and
    - (c) \$2,000,000 general aggregate.
  - (3) Workers compensation (statutory) and employer's liability: \$500,000 per accident/\$500,000 per disease/\$500,000 policy limit.
- (B) All licenses and permits issued requiring a certificate of insurance shall expire annually on the month and day indicated on the expiration date of the certificate of insurance.
- (C) The certificate of insurance shall specifically evidence the amount of insurance coverage, which shall remain in effect for the term of the license, and shall

- provide that written notice be given to the City Clerk 30 days prior to any change of coverage or termination of policy.
- (D) Individuals contracting directly with the city shall submit a certificate of insurance with at least the above stated minimum coverages and add the city as additional insured.

#### **Specifications/Scope of Work**

City has adopted the SUDAS Standard Specifications with the City's Municipal Design Standards. The City of Williamsburg's Municipal Design Standards may be obtained at city hall.

#### **General Repair Requirements**

- Removed damaged surfacing.
- Saw cut streets to a straight line.
- Excavate damaged areas to provide a minimum depth of 8" PCC and 6" of compacted stone.

#### **Specifications to be Used:**

 Williamsburg's Municipal Design Standards to Amend the 2021 Iowa Statewide Urban Design and Specifications (SUDAS) The Scope of Work and quantities can be found at the end of this Request for Proposal.

#### **Timeline and Award**

The City of Williamsburg is proposing the following timeline for the Request for Proposal process.

September 8, 2025: Award of Contract

October 31, 2025: Completion of Work & Invoiced

Award will be made to the lowest responsible proposal. Responsible bidders are defined as those demonstrating integrity, complying with public policy, possessing a record of positive past performance, and demonstrate the financial and technical resources necessary to complete the scope of work.

All contracts awarded will be lump sum contracts for the estimated for the Scope of Work. There will be no separate measurement or payment made for additional quantities. Contractors are encouraged to visit each site and satisfy themselves of quantities provided.
