Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the General Manager of Laurens Municipal Power & Communications, Laurens, Iowa, at the Municipal Office, 272 N 3rd Street, Laurens, IA 50554 until 1:30 PM, on October 14, 2025, at said time and place, proposals will be publicly opened and read. Bids will be acted upon by the Board of Trustees at a subsequent meeting.

The general nature of the work on which bids will be received consists of the modifications to the existing 15 kV switchgear at the East and West Substations and modifications to the control panel at the West Substation. This work includes the removal of existing relays, controls, and wiring, and the furnishing and installation of new relaying, controls, wiring, and communication cables. The work includes breaker retrofitting at the East Substation and 15 kV circuit breaker testing at the East Substation, West Substation, and the Generation Plant.

The above work shall be in accordance with the specifications and proposed form of contract now on file in the offices of, Laurens Municipal Power & Communications, Laurens, Iowa, by this reference, made a part hereof, as though fully set out and incorporated herein.

Each bid shall be made out on a blank form furnished by the Laurens Municipal Power & Communications and must contain bid security as required by Iowa Code Section 26.8. The bidder's security shall be in the form of either (1) a cashier's check or certified check drawn on a state chartered or federally chartered bank, in an amount equal to ten (10) percent of the amount of the Bid; or (2) a certified share draft drawn on a state-chartered or federally chartered credit union, in an amount equal to ten (10) percent of the amount of the Bid; or (3) a Bid Bond executed by a corporation authorized to contract as a surety in the State of Iowa, in an amount equal to ten (10) percent of the amount of the Bid. The bid security shall be made payable to Laurens Municipal Power & Communications. The bid security must not contain any conditions either in the body of as an endorsement thereon. Such bid security shall be forfeited to the Laurens Municipal Power & Communications as liquidated damages in the event the successful bidder fails or refuses to enter into a contract within fifteen (15) days after the award of the contract and post satisfactory Performance and Payment Bonds.

The sealed envelope containing the bid shall be clearly marked "BID ENCLOSED – RELAY UPGRADES AND SCADA SYSTEM REPLACEMENT" on the outside of the envelope.

Payment to the Contractor for said construction work will be made from cash on hand of such other funds that legally may be used or obtained for such purposes. Estimates will be paid monthly by the Utility to the Contractor in accordance with the following schedule:

Ninety-seven (97) percent upon certification of units completed; three (3) percent within thirty (30) days after final completion and acceptance.

Construction may be started after the execution of the Construction Agreement (the Contract) and the issuance of the Notice to Proceed. Substantial Completion of the project shall be no later than April 3, 2026. See the "Construction Schedule" of the Technical Specifications for special instructions relating to this project.

By virtue of statutory authority, a preference will be given to products and provisions grown, and coal produced within the State of Iowa, and preference shall be given to Iowa domestic labor in the construction of said improvements. The Owner will, in evaluating Bids, consider the requirements of the resident bidder preference law, and allow such preferences to resident bidders as are required to be allowed under State Law. Bidder shall, when submitting a Bid, furnish an executed Bidder Status Form for the Owner to use when applying the preference law. Failure to submit a fully completed Bidder Status Form with the bid may result in the bid being deemed nonresponsive and rejected.

Laurens Municipal Power & Communications reserves the right to defer acceptance of any bid for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days after the date bids are received and no bid may be withdrawn during this period. The Utilities also reserves the right to waive irregularities, reject any or all bids, and enter into such contract as it shall be deemed to be in the best interest of the Utility.
