#### Job summary:

Under general direction of Superintendent of Streets & Traffic Engineering, coordinates sign making, sign installation, sign inventory, sign retro reflectivity, temporary traffic control and pavement marking program. Operates light and heavy equipment.

### Minimum Education, Experience, Certification/Licensure, Other:

Associate's degree from an accredited educational institution or two years of related experience and/or equivalent combination of education and experience. Experience in street construction and maintenance. Satisfactory driving record. Valid State of Iowa commercial driver's license instruction permit upon first day in position. Valid State of Iowa Class A commercial driver's license with air brake and tank endorsements within 6 months of hire. Meet federal drug testing requirements. Requires a pre-employment drug screen. Must be 18 years of age. Must pass criminal background check. Must live within 25 miles of the corporate limits of Iowa City, Iowa within one year of appointment to the position.

## Preferred Education, Experience, Certification/Licensure, Other:

Associate's degree from an accredited educational institution and one year of related experience; or three years of related experience and/or equivalent combination of education and experience. Experience in sign making, installation, and repair. One year of pavement marking and striping experience. ATSSA certified in Temporary Traffic Control.
