

Chief of Police Greenfield, Iowa

The Chief leads a small, professional department of three full-time officers and works closely with regional law enforcement partners. The Chief provides overall leadership, direction, and management for all department operations, including supervision and mentoring, budgeting and policy development, fostering community trust and engagement, and emergency response coordination.

Minimum Requirements: Current ILEA Certification as a sworn peace officer. Minimum five (5) years of sworn law enforcement experience (supervisory experience preferred). Valid Iowa driver's license. Strong leadership, communication, and community relations skills. **Preferred Qualifications:** Prior command or supervisory experience, experience managing a small police department, experience with leading and managing SRO programs, and knowledge of municipal budgeting and policy development.
