

Notice to Bidders

City of Corning Seeks Residential Construction Contractors

The City of Corning seeks bids on multiple single-family residential rehabilitation projects in the city. The projects will be funded in part with federal dollars. Each project (house) will be bid and awarded individually to the lowest responsive and responsible bidders. Bidders must provide proof of insurance, registration with Iowa's Contractor Registry, and lead paint certification should they receive the best bid. We intend to accept bids on eight homes.

A voluntary contractor walkthrough is planned for 9 AM on Thursday, February 5, 2026, starting at City Hall, 601 6th Street, Corning, Iowa 50841. At precisely 9 AM, we will proceed to the first home. At each walkthrough, we will point out the work in the bid package and give bidders a chance to ask questions about the project and the expectations.

Bids will be due at 2 PM on Friday, February 20, 2026, at the office of the Southern Iowa Council of Governments, 101 E. Montgomery, Creston, Iowa 50801. They can be hand delivered, sent via mail, fax at 641-782-8492, or emailed to rounds@sicog.com. Incomplete and late bids will not be accepted.

Bids will be read aloud at SICOG's office, and all bidders will be notified of the results.

Construction work will begin this spring and end by early fall 2026. Contractors can bid on one or multiple projects.
