
Function

The City of Ankeny is seeking applications to complete a summer internship program as a Food & Beverage Intern for The Pinnacle Club at Otter Creek Golf Course. Under general direction of the Food and Beverage Manager, the intern is a member of the Food and Beverage Team and works closely with the Food and Beverage Manager and other banquet team members to learn all aspects of event operations including meal preparation, set up and clean up, and coordination of events with clients. This position will be responsible for storing and serving food with consistent quality and Food Safety procedures.

The compensation rate is set at **\$17.00 per hour**, 40 hours per week for 13 weeks, beginning mid-May to mid-August 2026. Pre-employment drug screen and background check is required.

- Assist with set-up and tear down of events, including moving tables, chairs, table settings, and linens.
- Assist food & beverage manager with concession operations.
