Description of Public Improvement

The Public Improvement, upon which bids are requested, generally consists of asphalt milling, pavement patching, curb-and gutter replacement, storm sewer intake and sanitary manhole replacement or adjustment, water main replacements and valve adjustments, ADA curb ramps, and associated work in preparation for HMA overlay by City forces located at seventeen (17) project locations including: 2nd Street SW from 3rd Avenue to 5th Avenue, 4th Street NW from E Avenue to G Avenue, 4th Street SW from RR tracks to 8th Avenue, 9th Street SW from 5th Avenue to 8th Avenue, 27th Avenue SW from 6th Street to L Street, 28th Avenue SW from 6th Street to L Street, B Avenue NE from 17th Street to 18th Street, Benton Street NE from 42nd Street to 46th Street, Bever Avenue SE Intersection with Green Valley Terrace, C Avenue NE from College Drive to 14th Street, D Avenue NE from 18th Street to 19th Street, G Avenue NW from Ellis Boulevard to 4th Street, Harbet Avenue NW from West Post Road to Gordon Avenue, Harold Drive SE from 38th Street to 14th Avenue, Kesler Road NW from Holly Avenue to Gordon Avenue, Parkland Drive SE from Park Lane to Trailridge Drive, Plainview Drive NW from West Post Road to Cherry Hill Road. Bid Security and Other Bonds

Each bidder shall accompany its bid with bid security as defined in Iowa Code Section 26.8, as security that the successful bidder will enter into a contract for the work bid upon and will furnish after the award of contract a corporate surety bond, in a form acceptable to the Jurisdiction, for the faithful performance of the contract, in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the amount of the contract. The bidder's security shall be in the amount of five percent (5 %) of the bid and shall be in the form of a cashier's check or a certified check drawn on an FDIC insured bank in Iowa or on an FDIC insured bank chartered under the laws of the United States; or a certified share draft drawn on a credit union in Iowa or chartered under the laws of the United States; or a bid bond on the form provided in the contract documents executed by a corporation authorized to contract as a surety in the State of Iowa. Bid security, other than said bid bond, shall be made payable to the City of Cedar Rapids. The bid shall contain no condition except as provided in the specifications.

Drug Free Workplace

The City of Cedar Rapids seeks to enhance worker safety by creating workplaces that are free of drugs and substance abuse. All contractors and subcontractors shall be responsible for pre-employment drug screening of prospective employees. All contractors and subcontractors shall have in place a drug and alcohol testing policy that conforms to the requirements of Iowa Code, and will be required to submit with their bid an acknowledgement attesting to this practice.

Applicable Laws and Regulations

By virtue of statutory authority, preference will be given to products and provisions grown and coal produced within the State of Iowa, and to Iowa domestic labor, to the extent lawfully required under Iowa Code Chapter 73.

In accordance with Iowa statutes, a resident bidder shall be allowed a preference as against a nonresident bidder from a state or foreign country if that state or foreign country gives or requires any preference to bidders from that state or foreign country, including but not limited to any preference to bidders, the imposition of any type of labor force preference, or any other form of preferential treatment to bidders or laborers from that state or foreign country. The preference allowed shall be equal to the preference given or required by the state or foreign country in which the nonresident bidder is a resident. In the instance of a resident labor force preference, a nonresident bidder shall apply the same resident labor force preference to a public improvement in this state as would be required in the construction of a public improvement by the state or foreign country in which the nonresident bidder is a resident.

Non-Discrimination Notice
