#### **Job summary:**

Under general direction, inspects, maintains and repairs the City's water distribution system. Operates heavy equipment and serves as group leader in performing general and emergency construction, maintenance and repair of water mains and related facilities. Performs location of underground water and fiber utilities, water taps and related water customer service work. Investigates customer service complaints.

#### **Minimum Education, Experience, Certification/Licensure, Other**

Associate's degree from an accredited educational institution and one year of related experience; or three years of related experience and/or equivalent combination of education and experience. Experience in water system installation and repair. State of Iowa DNR Grade II Water Distribution Certificate required within one year of hire. Satisfactory driving record. Valid State of Iowa commercial driver's license instruction permit upon first day in position. Valid State of Iowa Class A commercial driver's license with air brake and tank endorsements within 6 months of hire. Meet federal drug testing requirements. A pre-employment drug screen is required. Must be 18 years of age. Must pass criminal background check. Must live within 25 miles of the corporate limits of Iowa City, Iowa within one year of appointment to the position.

#### **Preferred Education, Experience, Certification/Licensure, Other**

Bachelor's degree from an accredited educational institution; or four years of related experience and/or equivalent combination of education and experience. State of Iowa DNR Grade III Water Distribution Certificate.
