

**Washington County Environmental Health  
Environmental Health Specialist**

Will be primarily responsible for inspection and regulation of food establishments and maintaining National Retail Food Regulatory Program Standards. Will be trained to do inspections for other environmental programs. This position requires extensive training and travel for required trainings.
