All bids shall be made on forms furnished by the City of Pella and obtained from McClure, 1535 SW Market Street Suite 200, Ankeny, Iowa 50023, 515-512-1361 and must be enclosed in a separate sealed envelope and plainly identified.

No bidder may withdraw a proposal **until after September 1, 2026**.

The right is reserved, as **City of Pella** may require, to reject any and all bids and to waive any informality in the bids received.

All Contractor(s) and subcontractor(s) are required to obtain tax exemption certificates from the **City of Pella, Iowa** for this project. These tax exemption certificates are only for use on this specific project as covered under the Contract. Before final payment will be made on this project, the Contractor(s) and subcontractor(s) shall provide lien waivers as required in the Specifications.

All work under the contract shall be completed and ready for operation on or before a date to be specified in the “Notice to Proceed”. The Contractor(s) shall fully complete all work, including deliver of the vehicle/equipment **by November 30<sup>th</sup> 2026**. Deliver shall be free on board (FOB) destination to the address noted herein below. Cash on Delivery (COD) deliveries will not be accepted. All vehicles/equipment shall be off-loaded at the designated location at the vendor’s expense.
