The City of Wiota, Iowa (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

WIOTA USDA PAVING PROJECT
WHKS PROJECT NO.: 10502

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the **WHKS Ames Office** located at **1421 South Bell Avenue, Suite 103**, until **Monday, July 13th at 2:00 P.M.** local time. At that time and place the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. Bids will be considered on Tuesday, July 21st at 6:00 P.M. in the Council Chambers at City Hall, 316 Center Street, Wiota, Iowa.

The Project includes the following Work:

The general nature of the work on which bids are being accepted is paving the streets in Wiota with a two-inch overlay of Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA), 2600 tons. Associated pavement Scarification 3550 S.Y., granular surfacing of drives and shoulders, ADA accommodations, and PCC curb and gutter (non-standard). The project also includes the installation and maintenance of traffic control devices.

Bids are requested for the following Contract: **City of Wiota – Street Improvements**

Owner anticipates that the Project's total bid price will be approximately **\$320,000**. The Project has an expected duration of **Twenty-five (25)** days. Work on the Project will commence upon the issuance of a written Notice to Proceed and shall be substantially completed by July 1, 2027. If the contractor begins work in 2026, the work must be substantially complete within that calendar year.

By virtue of statutory authority, preference will be given to products and provisions grown and coal produced within the State of Iowa.
