

Maharashtra B.Sc Nursing Selection Process 2021

Annual Intake – 40

Merit seats - 34

Management seats - 6

- The entire admissions to the B.Sc Nursing courses in Maharashtra for the next academic year will be based on admission guidelines for NEET-UG 2021. Therefore, all the admissions to the different courses and colleges will be based on the NEET-UG 2021 Counseling process.
- The first step in the selection process for the candidate is by filling out the “Preference Form” online. All the candidates will be selected based on the preference list chosen by the candidates. Candidates must ensure that the preferences filled in are final, as no changes will be allowed for later rounds.
- Candidates will be allowed to choose the preference list only after they appear for the physical verification of documents and clear the same as well. A provisional merit list will be released by the state CET cell of the eligible candidates.
- Candidates will be selected based on their performance in NEET-UG 2021 along with the preference selected by the candidates.
- Under NEET-UG Counseling Sessions, B.Sc Nursing selection processes may be completed in two or more rounds, depending on the vacancies available for each course.
- After the first round, candidates will not be required to fill in the online preference form, including in the “Mop Up Round”.
- Seats will be allotted based on the preferences filled in by the candidates.
- After the seats have been allotted, the candidates may either accept the college and course that have been allotted to them or wait for the second round of the seat allotment.
- If the candidate is satisfied with his/her seat in the college and course, they will have to submit a Status Retention Form, which once submitted, cannot be taken back.
- Candidates will be able to wait till the Mop-Up Round if they are not satisfied with the seat allotment. However, once the seat has been allotted and the Status Retention Form has been submitted, candidates will not be allowed to change their choices.
- The final merit list will be released by the respective authorities on the official website. https://info.mahacet.org/CAP2021/NEET_UG/
- The selection of the candidates who have gone through the entire admission procedure as mentioned by the cell will be considered final and will be binding on the candidate as well.
- After the seats have been allotted to the candidates and the status retention form has been submitted to the respective Deans of the college, candidates will further be required to have paid the Maharashtra B.Sc Nursing Fees 2021. Once selected, the student will pay the course fees and join the allotted college. There are plenty of colleges in Maharashtra offering BSc nursing courses.

- All candidates who have been selected must pay the course fee in the form of a Demand Draft from any Nationalized or Scheduled Commercial Bank in India, in favour of the Dean or Principal, payable at the respective College, or as has been defined by the college itself
