

EARN WHILE LEARN SCHEME (Kamva ani Shika Yojana)

The University provides a specific amount of grant-in aid to meet the educational expenses of the eligible, needy and poor students under this scheme.

The student prosecuting his regular studies of the UG course (excluding compulsory Internship training) of health sciences may apply under the said scheme.

The grant-in-aid of Rs.2000/- per month is admissible to every eligible student for a maximum period of eight months during every academic year. The Dean / Principal will allot College / hospital related work (two hrs. daily-excluding public holidays) to the eligible students.

5 students (3% reservation for physically challenged)

Per hour Rs. 50/- x 2hours x 20 days = Rs. 2000/- x 8 months = Rs. 16000/-

Eligibility criteria

- Last year's income of parents \leq 6 lac rupees.
- Only undergraduate students are eligible
- Following are not eligible:
 - Postgraduate students
 - Interns
 - NRI students
 - Outside Maharashtra State - OMS

Necessary documents:

- Application form (Annexure A) signed by Dean
- Last year's mark sheet (self attested copy)
- Last year's income certificate issued by Collector Office (self attested copy)
- Aadhar card of the student (self attested copy)
- Bank account details of college
- Details of work done by the student for 8 months excluding holidays within 15 days.

DHANWANTARI VIDYADHAN YOJANA

The University provides a specific amount as grant-in aid for repayment of the amount of interest on the education loan to the eligible students under this scheme.

The student who has taken education loan from the bank for his / her regular studies of the UG/PG course of health sciences from the affiliated College / recognized Institute of the University may apply under the said scheme

Up to Rs. 30000/- 15% UG students

Eligibility criteria Necessary documents

- Students should have taken educational loans.
- Last year's income of parents < 6 lac rupees.

Following are not eligible:-

- Interns
- NRI students
- Outside Maharashtra State – OMS
- Students getting Education Loan subsidy

SAVITRIBAI PHULE YOJANA

The University provides a specific amount as grant-in aid for educational expenses to the eligible, needy and poor female students under this scheme. The female student pursuing her regular studies of the UG course of health sciences from the affiliated College / recognized Institute of the University may apply under the said scheme.

The grant-in-aid is being provided to 03 female students of UG health science course of affiliated College / recognized Institute having 100 intake capacity.

Income of parents / family is the selection criteria for the said scheme.

Only for Girls. Rs. 25000/-

Eligibility criteria Necessary documents

- For GIRLS only

- Last year's income of parents < 6 lac rupees

SANJIVANI VIDYARTHI SURAKSHA YOJANA

The University is providing financial aid to the regular students of the affiliated Colleges / recognized Institutes of the University during prosecution of his / her studies.

Ranging from Rs. 2000 to 2 lakhs depending upon the severity of the illness

Under this scheme, after receipt of complete proposal due to following incidence the financial aid of amount shown against each incidence is being admissible:

- In case of death (either due to accident / natural calamity / illness / natural) of regular student Rs. 2,00,000/- is admissible to the parents of the deceased student.
- Permanent Disability of any two limbs, Rs. 2,00,000/- is admissible.
- Permanent Disability of any one limb, Rs.1,00,000/- is admissible.
- For surgery / treatment of major diseases (for e.g. surgery of brain, heart, liver, lungs, cancer, any organ transplantation), Actual amount of admissible bill of treatment or Rs. 50,000/- whichever is less is admissible.
- For bone fracture or minor surgery, actual amount of admissible bill of treatment or Rs. 10,000/- whichever is less is being admissible.
- For dialysis, Rs.2000/- per dialysis is admissible. (Maximum 04 dialysis per month).
- If, hospitalized due to an accident for more than 24 Hrs. then the actual amount of admissible bill of treatment or Rs.2,000/- whichever is less is being admissible.

(All of the above to be reported to the university within 10 days)

Necessary documents

- Depending upon the disease status -
- Discharge summary.
- Medicines/ investigations' bills.
- In case of accident- FIR, Police Punchnama
- In case of permanent disability- Disability certificate from the Civil Surgeon.
- 2 clinical photographs of the disability.

BAHISHAL SHIKSHAN MANDAL YOJANA

The University provides a specific amount as grant-in aid for conducting seminars / lectures for the students on different topics at college level. Under this scheme, the maximum amount of grant-in-aid of Rs. 10,000/- and Rs. 500/- as audit fees is granted.
