We reserve the right to modify this Policy or its terms relating to the Website and Services at any time, effective upon posting of an updated version of this Policy on the Website. When we do, we will revise the updated date at the bottom of this page.

We take the intellectual property rights of others seriously and require that all our users do the same. The US Digital Millennium Copyright Act (DMCA) established a process for addressing claims of copyright infringement that we have implemented in relation to Upstreet's Services. If you own a copyright or have authority to act on behalf of a copyright owner and want to report a claim that material is being infringed on or through an Upstreet Asset, please send a notice to our copyright agent that includes all the items below and we will promptly take appropriate action:

01

A description of the copyrighted work that you claim is being infringed;

02

A description of the material you claim is infringing and that you want removed or access to which you want disabled and the URL or other location of that material;

03

Your address, telephone number and email address;

04

The following statement: "I believe in good faith that the use of the copyrighted material I am complaining about is not authorised by the copyright owner, its agent or the law (e.g. as a fair use)";

05

The following statement: "The information in this notice is accurate and, under penalty of perjury, I am the owner, or authorised to act on behalf of the owner, of the copyright or of an exclusive right that is allegedly infringed"; and

06

An electronic or physical signature of the owner of the copyright or a person authorised to act on the owner's behalf.

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any portion of this Policy, Upstreet reserves the right to take no action upon receipt of a DMCA copyright infringement notification if it fails to comply with all the requirements of the DMCA for such notifications.

Please note that if you are unsure whether the material you are reporting is in fact infringing, you may wish to seek legal advice before submitting a notification to us. Please note that under 17 U.S.C. § 512(f), you may be liable for any damages, including costs and attorneys' fees incurred by us or our users, if you knowingly misrepresent that the material or activity is infringing.

We may, at our discretion or as required by law, share a copy of your notification or any correspondence with third parties.
